CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter the writer presents the conclusion and suggestion of this study. The conclusion is done based on the result of the data analysis and discussion in chapter IV, which is in line with the problem statement. The suggestion is done based on the conclusion which is got from the result of the data analysis and discussion. The conclusion and suggestion in detail are presented below.

5.1 Conclusions

The result of the study shows that semantic domains is the most least familiar to students is transportation based on The table (8) shows that, the words that belong to semantic domain of food and drinks are most familiar to students and the least familiar words are those that belong to the domain of transportation domain. some words of each semantic domains that have been acquired by the studens such as : bus, tractor, taxi,car, truck, bicyle, train, corn, sausage, wheat bread, peanuts, milk are acquired by less than 50% of the students. Moreover other words have not been acquired by all of the students e.g : cable car.

5.2 Suggestion

In this part, the writer would like to give suggestion that might be useful for English teacher and the students. The suggestion in detail are presented below:

a. For the English Teacher of researched School

The teacher should give more exercise on vocabulary especially for matching English vocabulary words of three semantic domains.
