CHAPTER V

In this chapter, the writer presents the conclusion of the study and gives suggestions based on the result of the analysis and discussion.

5.1 Conclusion

From the discussion of the study, the writer will conclude that

- 1. The grammatical errors which were made by the tenth grade students of SMA Negeri 2 Kota Kupang in the school year 2018/2019 in writing descriptive text were: 146 (55.09%) Omission, 90 (33.96%) misformation, 24 (9.05%) addition, 6 (2.26%) misordering.
- 2. The most common error that was made in writing descriptive text by the tenth grade students of SMA Negeri 2 Kota Kupang was omission with total number of errors were 146 (55.09%).

5.2 Suggestions

Based on above conclusion the writer will give some suggestions:

1. For the students, they should learn more how to write well especially in writing descriptive text. The most common errors made by tenth grade students is omission. Students should pay attention to the tense that they use in writing descriptive text. Nowdays, a lot of sources the students can access

- 2. For the teacher of the research school is they should teach the students how to compose a good writing especially in writing descriptive text and should use some methods that make students enjoy in learning writing.
