CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer presents the conclusions of the study and gives suggestions based on the result of the analysis and discussion

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the analysis in chapter IV then the conclusion are:

- The grammatical errors committed by the eleventh grade students of SMAK SintCaroluskupangwere misformation, addition, omission, and misordering.
- The most common grammatical errors commited by the eleventh grade students of SMSK SintCarolusKupang were misformation (69.9%) made by 17 students followed by Addition (23,7%) made by 15 students, omission (13,9%) made by 12 students and Misordering (3,22%) made by 3 students.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the conclusion the writer would like to give the following suggestion specifically for the teacher of English at the researched school. The teacher should pay more attention on the students' grammar when teaching especially in writing recount text.

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
