CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the result of the analysis, the writer comes to some conclusions. The conclusions are actually the answers to the problem statement stated in chapter one, Introduction .The conclusions in details are presented below.

- a. The eleventh grade students of SMAN 7 Kupang are able to understand the text they read.
