CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter the writer would like to presents about the conclusions and suggestions based on the result of the study.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the data analysis presented in the previous chapter, the writer comes to the conclusion. There are some points found as follows:

- 1. The grammatical errors whichwere made by the students in constructing descriptive text are 125 (100%). The writer found all the types of errors, namely, misformation 52 (42%), Omission 49 (39%), Addition 21 (17%) and Misordering 4 (3%).
- 2. The most common grammatical errorscommitted by the students in writing descriptive text is misformation 52 times (42%). In the second position is omission, and it followed by addition and misordering..

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the conclusion the writer would like to give the following suggestion.

- The students are recommended to practice the grammar of English and writing descriptive text more intensely.
- 2. The English teacher is recommended to teach the grammar of English and writing descriptive text more intensely.
