CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer draws some conclusions and suggestions based on the data analysis of this study.

5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing and discussing the students error in writing recount text, the writer can conclude that:

- 1. The errors made by the eleventh grade students of SMAN 1 Kupang in writing recount text were omission, addition, misformation and misordering. The number of errors in grammar was 70. The common errors in grammar was omission 19 (27,14%), addition 15 (21,42%), misformation 31 (44,28%) and misordering 5 (7,14%).
- 2. The most common error committed by the students in writing recount text is misformation 31 (44,28%)

5.2 Suggestion

The writer would like to give some suggestions to teachers and students that might be useful for improving in grammatical errors writing recount text.

1. For the teacher

The teacher should give more emphasis on grammatical aspect especially in using simple past tense, subject and verb agreement, using modal and pronoun, article and preposition also how to make a good sentence because the students still lack of knowledge in these part.

2. For the Students

The eleventh grade students of SMAN 1 Kupang should learn more how to write a good text and focused on grammar especially about tenses.

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
