

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the writer would like to present some conclusions and suggestions based on the analysis.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the analysis in chapter four, it can be concluded that:

- a. The second year students of SMAK Sint Carolus are able to present the procedure text orally in front of the class.
- b. Their level of ability is classified as very good.
- c. Although their ability level is already very good but the writer also found that students still committed many errors regarding: grammar (preposition, uncountable/countable noun, suffix), vocabulary, and pronunciation.

After concluding, the writer has addition finding about the students' speaking performance the students did not mention the use of sugar in making tea or coffee.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the result of study and the conclusion drawn above, some suggestions can be given, especially to the English teachers of SMAK Sint Carolus and to the students themselves.

a. To English Teacher

It is advisable to train the students to speak English in front of the class in presenting something like procedure text, daily life, or other material, and motivates the students in order to read more to increase their language skill.

b. To Students

For grammar and pronunciation, the students should try to improve their pronunciation by listening to the radio, song and TV programs which use English. They are also advised to enrich themselves with more vocabularies, such as by reading English book. In the class room if the student not understand yet what their English teacher teaches, they should ask their English teacher to teach again what they don't understand.

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
