

CHAPTER IV

ANALYSIS AND DISCUSSION

Analysis and discussion in this chapter were based on the data obtained from the field research. The data were the result of the test done by the eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Familia Kupang. There were 20 students who joined the test.

1.1 Identification

As stated in the beginning of chapter I, the writer only focused on student's ability in pronouncing the irregular verbs. Thus, the writer would only concern on the ability level of the eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Familia and what are the difficulties that might be faced by the eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Familia.

1.2 Data Analysis

This part presents the result of the test. It consisted of 34 irregular verbs in the three forms: V1, V2, V3. The score based on the percentage of correct pronounce. To know the result of the students score clearly the writer used the following table.

By looking over the table above the total scores of the students ability in pronouncing the irregular verbs amount to 1.878 and the number of the students who have been researched their ability to pronounce the irregular verbs was 20 students. Based on the total scores and the number of students, the mean score can be obtained by using formula which has been stated in the previous section, namely;

The table above shows that, 10 students (50%) got excellent level of ability, 9 students (45%) got very good ability, 1 students (5%) got good ability. And none of the students got fairly, poor and very poor ability. The mean score of the students was 93,9. So we can conclude that mostly students were classified as very good level of ability in pronouncing the irregular verbs.

4.3 Discussion

In this part, the writer would like to discuss about the research questions in this study.

To answer the first question which is “what is the ability level of the eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Familia in pronouncing the irregular verbs?” The researcher conducted the test. The test is about pronouncing the irregular verbs. The test was given about 34 (102 words) of irregular verbs, while the students

pronounce the irregular verbs and the research record the student's pronunciations. And then, the researcher analysis the students pronunciation, from the analysis 10 students (50%) got excellent competence, 9 students (45%) got very good competence, 1 student (5%) got good competence. The mean score of the students was 93,9. So that the ability level of the eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Familia is 93,9.

To answer the second questions which is "Are the students of SMPK Sta. Familia able to pronounce the irregular verbs?" From the first question we know that students of SMPK Sta. Familia has a good level of ability, so to answer the seconds question we can assume that students of SMPK Sta. Familia able to pronounce the irregular verbs.

To answer the third questions which is "What are the difficulties faced by the eighth grade students of SMPK Sta. Familia in pronouncing the irregular verbs?" Although the students has good pronunciations on irregular verbs there are some difficulties faced by the students in pronouncing the words. Such words include: awoke, bite, cost, left, shake, shoot, wear, and
