

CHAPTER IV

ANALYSIS AND DISCUSSION

In this chapter the writer would like to analyze and discuss about the collected data which shows the frequency of grammatical errors made by the students in writing recount text. The writer analyzed those errors based on a modified Surface Strategy Taxonomy.

There are two main parts of this chapter. They are data analysis and discussion. In the following section, the writer would like to present the analysis of the gathered data in form of tables that would be beneficial for the readers to understand the whole analysis.

4.1 Data Analysis

In this section the writer provides some subparts.

4.1.1 Data Presentation

In this part, the writer presents the collected data of students' grammatical errors in writing recount text. In identifying and classifying the grammatical errors based on a modified surface strategy taxonomy, the writer uses the following types of markings; omission error is marked by ^, addition error is marked by **bold**, misformation error is marked by *italic*, misordering error is marked by underline and miscellaneous error is marked by *italic* and **bold**.

The formula to measure the percentage is $\frac{\text{Number of types errors}}{\text{Total Errors}} \times 100$

As shown on the table, the total number of grammatical errors committed by the students in writing recount text is **130 (100%)**. Most of students made errors in Misformation with the total number of error is 90 (69%) committed by 23 students, Omission 29 (22%) committed by 15 students, Addition 8 (6%) committed by 6 students and Misordering 3 (2%) committed by 2 students. Thus the most common error made in the students writing is Misformation, in the second place is Omission, and then followed by Addition and Misordering.

4.2 Discussion

In this part, the writer would like to discuss about the finding errors that students made in their writing recount text based on a surface strategy taxonomy. As it shown in the data analysis, the highest number of errors type is Misformation (69%), Omission (22%), Addition (6%) and the least is Misordering (2%). In the following part, the writer will discuss each type of error by taking some examples from the students' writing.

4.2.1 Omission

Omission is characterized by the absence of an item that must appear in a well-formed utterance. Almost of the students made same grammatical errors in constructing recount text under the category of omission. The omission errors lie on suffix (-s) to express plural noun, omission of article (a and the), omission of preposition (of, on, at, in, to), omission of to be (was and were), omission of verb (go) and omission of adverb (back and there), omission of conjunction (and) and possessive noun.

1. Omission of Student 1

- a. we went back ^ the hotel.

In this sentence, the student made error in the form of omission of preposition of place. The preposition of place is used to refer to a place where someone or something is located. Therefore, the correct sentence is:

We went back to the hotel.

2. Omission of Student 5

- a. ^ next day, we went to the beach

In this sentence, the student made error in the form of omission of definite article (the) to indicate something specific Thus, the correct sentence is:

The next day, we went to the beach.

3. Omission of Student 6

- a. last year, my brother an^ I went to Bali

In this sentence, the student made error in the form of omission of letter (d) in conjunction (and). The letter (d) in the conjunction is omitted. There must be an (and) to indicate connection or addition in a sentence. Thus, the correct sentence is: Last year, my brother and I went to Bali.

- b. we stayed in our family^ house in Klungkung

In this sentence, the student made error in the form of omission of an apostrophe (‘) and (-s) to the noun (our family). To explain possession of noun, it should be added by an apostrophe (‘) and (-s) to the noun (our family). Thus, the correct sentence is: We stayed in our family’s house in Klungkung.

4. Omission of Student 7

- a. the monkeys ate the banana[^], peanut[^] and food from the tourist[^].

In this sentence, the student made error in the form of omission of suffix –s behind the countable nouns that refers to plural. Thus, the correct sentence is: the monkeys ate bananas, peanuts and food from the tourists.

4.2.2 Addition

Addition is the opposite of omission. It is characterized by the presence of an item, which must not appear in a well-formed utterance. Students made some errors by addition of unnecessary word, suffix (-d/ -ed, -s), and addition of verb, noun and article. Here are some of the examples.

1. Addition of Student 4

- a. I went to Surabaya to joined St. Louis choir competition

In this sentence, there is an addition of suffix –ed behind the verb (joined). To infinitive should be followed by base form (V1). Thus, the correct sentence is: I went to Surabaya to joined St. Louis choir competition.

2. Addition of Student 6

- a. I went to Bali to visited our family.
- b. In this sentence, there is an addition of suffix (-ed) in the verb (visit). To infinitive should be followed by base form or V1. Thus, the correct sentence is: I went to Bali to visit our family.

4.2.3 Misformation

It is characterized by the use of the wrong form of morpheme or structure. From the students worksheet, the writer found that the students made some errors

in the use of to be (was, were), verb, pronoun, preposition and adjective. Here are some examples.

1. Misformation of Student 13

- a. I see a big snake behind the plants.

In this sentence, the verb (see) is misformed. Simple past form is required to refer to the action happened and ended in the past time. The verb is formed in the present time. Thus, the correct sentence is: I saw a big snake behind the plants.

2. Misformation of Student 15

- a. an embarasing moment

In this sentence, there is a misformation of adjective that modifies the noun which is the wrong construction of the word. Thus, the correct sentence is: An Embarrassing Moment.

4.2.4 Misordering

It is characterized by the incorrect placement of morpheme or a group of morphemes in an utterance. From the students' answer sheet the writer found that students made some errors in misordering of adjective explain a noun, frequency adverb that should be placed after subject and wrong construction of eorr in sentence.

1. Misordering of Student 13

- a. I bought Jasuke and water mineral

In this sentence, the construction of the noun phrase is misordered. Adjectives are used to modify noun or noun phrase. Typically, an adjective

is placed before noun or noun phrase. Thus, the correct sentence is: I bought Jasuke and mineral water.

2. Misordering of Student 24

- a. I went to watch a movie horror entitled “The Conjuring 2”

In this sentence, the construction of the noun phrase is misordered.

Adjectives are used to modify noun or noun phrase. Typically, an adjective is placed before noun or noun phrase. Therefore, the correct sentence is: I went to watch a movie horror entitled “The Conjuring 2”.
