CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, the writer provides the conclusion and suggestions for this study.

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the data analysis of this study, the writer can draw some conclusions as follows:

- 1. The British Council Module is effective in enhancing students' vocabulary mastery. This can be seen from the improvement of students' mean scores from the pre-test, post-test I, and post-test II. The mean score of Pre-test 59.37 increased to the mean score 77.05 in the Post-test I 77.55, and lastly, increased to 88.74 in Post-test II.
- 2. From the research conducted, it is evident that one significant challenge students faced while implementing the British Council module was the varying levels of prior knowledge among them. While some students were able to grasp the content quickly, others needed more time and support to catch up. This difference in ability created a gap that affected group activities and discussions. Overall, addressing this challenge is essential to enhance student learning and engagement with the module.

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the conclusions above, the writer provides several suggestions as follows:

1. For Teachers

The findings of this study indicate that the use of the British Council module is effective in enhancing students' vocabulary mastery, especially in the daily routine domain. However, teachers are encouraged to utilize a proper teaching method and teaching materials that suit the module, as well as create a good lesson plan for learning activities. It is also crucial for teachers to prepare students by introducing relevant vocabulary before giving the test. This helps students build confidence, understand the content better, and be able to express their ideas in individual or group work.

2. For Future Researchers

This study focused on enhancing students' vocabulary mastery using the British Council module, specifically in the daily routine domain. Future researchers are encouraged to explore other vocabulary domains of the British Council to expand the potential of the modules. Moreover, future research could be conducted at different educational levels or with larger groups of participants to gain broader insights into the effectiveness of the British Council module. Further investigation could also explore the long-term impact of using the British Council module in enhancing students' vocabulary mastery.
