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ABSTRACT

The title of this research is ""Analysis of Request Expressions in Uab Meto". This research was conducted to answer two problems, namely 1) What are the types of request expressions used in Uab Meto? And 2) How to express a request in Uab Meto? The objectives are to 1) identify the types of request expressions commonly used in Uab Meto and, 2) identify request strategies used in Uab Meto. This research focuses on the expression of requests in the context of everyday situations using qualitative methods. Data were collected through questionnaires given to several participants who were native speakers or L1 speakers at Uab Meto which included 10 request situations. Research participants consisted of people in Taiftob Village, North Mollo District, South Central Timor Regency, East Nusa Tenggara Province. They consisted of 5 men (Atoin Meto) and 5 women (Bife Meto) with an age range of 21-60 years, all of whom were native speakers of the Uab Meto language who lived in the village. The request expression analysis method in this research refers to the classification of request patterns in the Cross-Cultural Study of Speech Act Realization Pattern (CCSARP) proposed by Blum-Kulka et al. (1989). The results showed that the most common request expressions used by Uab Meto participants were conventional indirect requests, followed by direct requests, while non-conventional indirect requests were less preferred. The analysis also showed that there were no significant differences between men and women. Based on the results mentioned previously, the researcher suggests to future researchers to study the expression of requests comprehensively by paying attention to aspects of gender and language contact; stakeholders....

ABSTRAK

Judul penelitian ini adalah "Analisis Ungkapan Permintaan dalam Uab Meto". Penelitian ini dilakukan untuk menjawab tiga permasalahan yaitu 1) Apa saja jenis-jenis ungkapan permintaan yang digunakan dalam Uab Meto? Dan 2) Bagaimana mengungkapkan permintaan dalam Uab Meto? Tujuannya, untuk 1) mengidentifikasi jenis-jenis ungkapan permintaan yang biasa digunakan dalam Uab Meto, serta 2) mengidentifikasi strategi- strategi permintaan yang dipakai dalam Uab Meto. Penelitian ini berfokus pada ungkapan permintaan dalam konteks situasi sehari-hari dengan menggunakan metode kualitatif. Data dikumpulkan melalui kuesioner yang diberikan kepada beberapa partisipan penutur asli atau penutur L1 Uab Meto yang mencakup 10 situasi permintaan. Partisipan penelitian terdiri dari masyarakat di Desa Taiftob, Kecamatan Mollo Utara, Kabupaten Timor Tengah Selatan, Provinsi Nusa Tenggara Timur. Mereka terdiri dari 5 orang laki-laki (Atoin Meto) dan 5 orang perempuan (Bife Meto) dengan rentang usia 21-60 tahun, semuanya merupakan penutur asli bahasa Uab Meto yang tinggal di desa tersebut. Metode analisis ungkapan permintaan dalam penelitian ini mengacu pada klasifikasi pola permintaan dalam Cross-Cultural Study of Speech Act Realization Pattern (CCSARP) yang diusulkan oleh Blum-Kulka dkk. (1989). Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa ekspresi permintaan yang paling umum digunakan oleh peserta Uab Meto adalah permintaan tidak langsung konvensional, diikuti oleh permintaan langsung, sedangkan permintaan tidak langsung non-konvensional kurang disukai. Analisis juga menunjukkan bahwa tidak ada perbedaan yang signifikan antara laki-laki dan perempuan. Berdasarkan hasil yang disebutkan sebelumnya, peneliti menyarankan kepada peneliti-peneliti berikutnya untuk mengkaji ekspresi permintaan secara komprehensif dengan memperhatikan aspek gender dan kontak bahasa, pemangku kepentingan
