## **1.2 Problem Statement**

## **1.3 Objective of the Study**

2. To find out the most common errors in writing recount text of the eighth grade students of SMP Negeri 4 Kupang in the school year 2019/2020.

## **1.5 Scope and Limitation**

The study is concerned with analyzing of errors in grammatical features (using of simple past tense, verb and descriptive words) made by the eighth grade of SMP Negeri 4 Kupang in their writing of recount text.

## **1.6 Definition of Terms**

To help the readers understand this study, the writer gives some definitions of the terms related to this study:

### **1. Recount Text**

Anderson (1997: 24) stated that a recount text is a piece of text retelling past events, usually in the order in which they happened. The purpose of a recount text is to give the audience a description of what occurred and when it occurred.

### **2. Grammar**

Harmer (2001: 12) defines grammar as the description of the ways in which words can change their forms and can be combined into sentences in that language.

### **3. Error Analysis**

Error analysis is a way to know about the error made by the EFL students. This study also identifies the types and causes of language errors made by the EFL student based on some perspectives.

#### 4. Differences between Error and Mistake

There is a big difference between error and mistake. Error is systematic deviation from the normal rule which is not recognized by the students, While the mistake was making by the students and can be corrected.
