

CHAPTER IV

ANALYSIS AND DISCUSSION

In this chapter the writer analyzed and discussed the errors made by the students in their writing recount text. The writer analyzed those errors based on four aspects in surface strategy taxonomy. They are omission, addition, misordering and misformation.

1.1. Data Analysis

The writer put some marks for every sentence contains grammatical error using certain character such as: addition is marked by underline, omission is marked by bold underline, misordering is marked by bold italic and misformation is marked by italic underline.

4.2 Discussion

After identification, classifying, and calculating the writer found there were four errors made by student in writing recount texts. The most frequent of errors are in misformation (72.7%) with the total errors 80 made by 20 students. In Omission (15.3%) made by 12 students with the total of 17 errors, followed by Addition (9.00%) made by 8 students with the total 10 errors, and the last is misordering (3.60%) made by 4 students and the total 4 errors. Then the writer found many error regarding misformation error, as represented in the work sheet of student 1 below :

(-) I want to play table tennis

(+)I wanted to play table tennis..

The student 1 make a misformation error of 'want' this is a nominal sentence. In simple past tense verb 1 replaced by 'verb 2'.

There were some other examples of the some problems in which a sentence could contain more than one types of errors. As has been mentioned above that the most common types of errors added by eighth grade students of SMP Negeri 4 kupang was misformation error. Regarding this, the writer interpreted that the eighth grade students knowledge of verb was still low, it could be proven with the numbers of errors they added even though they did not produce many sentence in their writing.
