

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the results of data analysis and the results of research and discussion in the previous chapter, the study concluded that:

1. Students' ability to develop ideas for writing content descriptive text is good. Students can develop the topics that have been given but some students, In developing content ideas including (introductory sentences, sentence descriptions and conclusions from sentences) lacking vocabulary and also still unsure in choosing correct words when writing descriptive text. So, they are confused how to write and express their ideas in papers related to the topic. This can be seen from the results of the average score in writing is 5.4. Which means it must be improved.
2. Students' difficulties in writing descriptive texts were developing ideas, grammar (tense adjective) and mechanics (capital letter)

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the results of this study, the researchers provide several suggestions as follows:

1. Fourth semester lecturer of English Department at WidyaMandira Catholic University Kupang must improve teaching methods and motivate students to write. lecturer must help students to make good texts by providing various ways to develop their ideas. Lecturers also give time for students to practice writing skills and lecturers brainstorm ideas and make outlines before doing writing activities. Outlines will help students in develop their ideas well.
2. Students must pay attention to the lecturer's explanation, and learn not to repeat the same mistakes.
3. For further researchers it is recommended to use the results of this study as a reference for addiction to conduct similar research.

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
