CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Study

Reading comprehension skills become an important part in reading activities for English language students especially for students who learn English as a foreign language. Reading without comprehension will be useless because students just read the text without even understand meaning of the text. Harvey (2011:2) states that in order to have comprehension in reading, students are required to actually know and understand what they are reading. When the students comprehend a text, they must be able to understand and imagine the context of the reading text. Yukselir (2014:65) specifically mentions that reading comprehension is the result of complex interactions between text, setting, the reader, and the reader's background.
