

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, the writer gives conclusion and suggestion dealing with the obtained result of the data analysis and discussion.

5.1. Conclusion

Based on the result of the data analysis, the writer comes to the conclusions. Those conclusions are presented in the following:

1. In general it can be said that the eighth grade students of SMP Negeri 10 Kupang in the school year 2014/2015 still have difficulty in using Wh-questions.
2. The mastery level of the eighth grade students of SMP Negeri 10 Kupang in the school year 2014/2015 in using Wh-questions is classified as Below Average level (5.57) according to the standard of measurement used in the researched school.
3. The students found difficulties in using Who, How, Which, Whose, and Who.

5.2. Suggestions

Since the class mastery level is below average, there were some students who did not pass the test. The writer would like to give some suggestions which might be useful for the teaching of Wh-questions. They are as follows:

1. The teacher should give more explanations and exercises on the use of Wh-questions to the students in order that their mastery level is better, particularly Who functioning as subject, Whose functioning as possessive, Whom functioning as object and What used for asking particularly information about somebody / something.
2. The students must improve their knowledge about using Wh questions in simple present tense and simple past tense and apply it through listening, speaking, reading and writing.

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
