CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Study

Language is a tool for communication. With language people can express ideas, thoughts, feelings, and other things, or what they want to do or what they want others to do. There are so many languages in the word. One of so many languages is English.

- 2) He isn't a teacher, does he?
- 3) Open the door, can you?

The correct sentence must be:

- 1) I am a student, aren't I?
- 2) He isn't a teacher, is he?
- 3) Open the door, will you?

Based on the problem above the writer is interested in conducting a study under the title "A Study on the Ability in Using Question Tag of the Eleventh Grade Students of SMA Negeri 1 Soe in the School Year 2014/2015"

1.2 Statement of the Problem

The problem is specified from the topic. The problem of this study is formulated in the following questions that should be answered in data analysis. The problem statements in details are presented below.

- 1. What is the level of ability in using question tag of the eleventh grade students of SMAN 1 Soe?

There are many grammatical structures in English. One of them is Question Tag. This study only focuses on English Question Tag. The question tag covers affirmative, negative, and imperative forms. The three forms were involved in the test.

1.6 Definition of Terms

In the following, the writer would like to define some terms which have to be clarified from the title of this writing. They are as follows:

1. Ability

Ability is potential, capacity, or power to do something physically or mental (S. Hornby, 1987; 2). In this study it means the students' capacity in using English Question Tag.

2. Question Tag

Question Tag as a phrase which id added at the end of sentence (Azar, 1989).

Question Tag in this study expressed in positive question tag, negative question tag and imperative question tag.

3. SMAN 1 Soe

SMAN 1 Soe is a public Senior High School which is located in Soe. The capital city of South Central Timor Regency. It located at Jl. Prof. W.Z Yohanes No.33 Soe, South Central Timor.
