##### **5.1.2 The Similarities and the Differences**

In the following section, the writer would like to present the similarities and the differences of the sentence patterns of Soa Dialect of Bajawa Language and those of English.

#### **1. The Similarities**

There are some similarities between Soa dialect and English. The similarities consist the following patterns: (1) Noun – Verb; (2) Noun – Verb – Noun; (3) Noun – Linking Verb – Adjective; (4) Noun – Verb – Noun – Adjective.
