CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1. 1. Background

Language is an element of communication among nations or societies. It is used to express or share an idea, and feelings. Language is an important tool of human life. The world without language is like a silent world and its unimaginable. Brown (2007: 6) said that language is used for communication and language operates in a speech community or culture. In the other words we can say that language and communication are so closely related to each other.

Therefore in this study the writer focuses on the students' ability in Oral Presentation. 1. 2. Problem Statement

1. 3. Objectives of Study

1. 4. Significance of Study

1. For the teacher

This study provides some useful information in doing oral presentation in classroom activities so the teacher can use this method to increase and build students ability in every skills especially speaking in learning English.

By using an oral presentation method the students are helped to be more active in using English during teaching and learning process. This method can also build a good communication/cooperation in classroom between students and students or teacher and students.

3. For the readers'

4. For the writer

1. 5. Scope and Limitation

1. 6. Definition of Term

1. Speaking

Speaking in this study means, when students do the oral presentation they also doing an interaction with the audience like producing the information and the audience will receive the information.

2. Ability

According to Hornby (1974: 2) ability is a capacity or power to do something physically or mentally, while according to Quirk, et al. (1978: 873), ability is the fact of having a skill, power, or other qualities that are needed in order to do something. So ability here means the student's competence to do the oral presentation.

3. Oral presentation

An oral presentation is a form of assessment that teachers frequently use in the classroom (www.ehow.com:2014). Oral presentation here means assessment from the teacher to increase students' ability to be more active in classroom.
