CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter the writer would like to present about the conclusions and suggestions based on the result of the study.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the data analysis presented in the previous chapter, the writer comes to the conclusion. There are some points found as follows:

- 1. The grammatical error that were made by the students in constructing descriptive text is 147 (100%). The writer found all the types of errors, namely Omission 67 (46%), Addition 5 (3%), Misformation 68 (46%), Misordering 7 (5%).
- 2. The most common grammatical error committed by the students in writing descriptive text is Misformation 68 times (46%). In the second position is Omission 67 (46%), and it is followed by Misordering 7 (5%) and Addition 5 (3%).

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the conclusion the writer would like to give the following suggestions.

 The students should master grammatical aspect in producing a descriptive text by doing more practices in writing. 2. English teacher should pay more attention on students' grammatical aspect of writing by providing exercises and drills particularly tenses.
